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Attachment A

Paragraph 4: Statement of the Purpose of the Corporation

A. To give the following aid to victims of war, persecution, unfair discrimination, and natural disasters, including refugees and refugee claimants and their families:

- A.1 Aid and/or sponsor victims' and their families' immigration to Canada
- A.2 Provide counselling and practical and financial aid to immigrants to facilitate their settling in Canada and integrating into Canadian society.
- A.3 Relieve the poverty of immigrants by providing them with financial and/or in kind support, helping them to apply for and receive appropriate government and charitable services in accordance with their needs, and helping them in their endeavours to gain employment and become financially self-supporting.
- A.4 Provide counselling and referrals to professionals to help in dealing with emotional needs.
- A.5 Advance the education of immigrants by providing counselling regarding institutions appropriate to their needs and the needs of their children, by providing books and equipment in accordance with their needs, and by providing volunteers to assist with homework and language skills.
- A.6 Facilitate immigrants' religious, cultural and recreational activities.
- B. Conclude written contracts with agents to provide the aid set out in subparagraph A above to such victims outside Canada.
- C. Receive and maintain a fund or funds and to apply all or part of the principal and income therefrom, from to time, to qualified donees as defined in subsection 149.1(1) of the Income Tax Act (Canada) in furtherance of the purposes set out above.
- D. Raise funds and employ employees, independent contractors, professional persons and volunteers for the purposes set out above.

Attachment B:

paragraph 8: Additional Provisions

8.1 Non-profit clause

This corporation shall be carried on without the purpose of gain for its members, and any profits or other accretions to the corporation shall be used in furtherance of its purposes.

8.2 Remuneration of Directors

Directors shall serve without remuneration, and no director shall directly or indirectly receive any profit from his or her position as such, provided that a director may be reimbursed for reasonable expenses incurred in performing his or her duties. A director shall not be prohibited from receiving compensation for services provided to the corporation in another capacity.

8.3 Additional Directors

The directors may appoint one or more directors, who shall hold office for a term expiring not later than the close of the next annual general meeting of members, but the total number of directors so appointed may not exceed one third of the number of directors.

8.4 Minimum number of Directors

The Corporation shall have a minimum of three directors, at least two of whom are not officers or employees of the corporation or its affiliates.
