Re: We do not have the information you asked for – 2022-01410-PRE / PRE-22-49

Office of the Premier received your application for access to information under the *Freedom of Information* and *Protection of Privacy Act (FOIPOP)* on September 8, 2022. In your application, you requested a copy of the following records:

In early January 2022, a US Federal Judge, Mark Pittman ordered Pfizer to release 55,000 pages per month on the vaccine safety data in a response to a FOI request filed on behalf of Public Health and Medical Professionals for Transparency. The List of Adverse Events of Special Interest totals over eight pages in length that includes neonatal death and sudden unexplained death. I would like to request all records and correspondence that the Premier's office has on the topic of Pfizer's safety data that has been released since January 10, 2022. Attached is an example of Pfizer's Safety Data. (Date Range for Record Search: From 01/09/2022 To 09/06/2022)

After a file search, we have located no records responsive to your application. Therefore, it is my understanding, pursuant to clause 7(2)(b) of the Act, that the Office of the Premier does not have custody or control of records which would respond to your application.

I am unaware of a department or agency which would hold such records.

You have the right to ask for a review of this decision by the Information Access and Privacy Commissioner (formerly the Review Officer). You have 60 days from the date of this letter to exercise this right. If you wish to ask for a review, you may do so on Form 7, a copy of which is attached. Send the completed form to the Information Access and Privacy Commissioner, P.O. Box 181, Halifax, Nova Scotia B3J 2M4.

Please be advised that a de-identified copy of this disclosure letter and the attached response to your *FOIPOP Act* application will be made public after 14 days. The package will be posted online at <a href="https://openinformation.novascotia.ca/">https://openinformation.novascotia.ca/</a>. The letter will not include your name, address, or any other personal information that you have supplied while making your application under *FOIPOP Act*.
