## Re: No Responsive Records – OUR FILE# NSHA-2022-181

On October 14, 2022, Nova Scotia Health (NSH) received your request under the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act* (*FOIPOP Act*).

We understand your application to be for a copy of the following:

- Blank AEFI form
- the number of forms filled out by doctors in NS for compensation for an AEFI
- how many were approved AEFI compensation forms
- how many were denied AEFI compensation forms

We have conducted a thorough search of our records, but we were not able to find any records responsive to your request.
