Submission of the Petitioners, Hsiang et al and Hoogerbrug, on the Adjournment of the Hearing

- 1. It is essential from the view of the Petitioners, Hsiang et al and Hoogerbrug, that the record before the Court be complete.
- 2. This means including all relevant documents most importantly, studies and other materials pertaining to the reasonableness of the continuation of the vaccination mandate.

- 3. There is a new Order dated April 6, 2023, that continues the vaccination mandate.
- 4. The Petitioners, Hsiang et al and Hoogerbrug, will amend their Petitions to include the new Order continuing the vaccination mandate.
- 5. The Petitioners and Respondents will then have to determine the record before the Provincial Health Officer as of the date of the new Order.
- 6. It will not be possible to do this and then prepare arguments based on this record before the hearing dates scheduled in May 2023.
- 7. Therefore, the Petitioners, Hsiang et al and Hoogerbrug, submit that the hearing should be adjourned until a mutually convenient time for the parties and the Court this fall.
- 8. The hearing of all the current petitions should be adjourned. To properly adjudicate these petitions, the Court needs to consider the record as of the date of the new Order. It serves no useful purpose for the Court to adjudicate some of the Petitions on an incomplete record.
